Players' parents shall

- Always respect the decisions of the Club Management

- Never get involved in confrontational situations with parents from other clubs
- Assist team managers in offering the payment of weekly subscriptions
- Never verbally abuse the referee
- Never get involved in violent conduct either on or off the pitch.

Players shall

- Be respectful to other players on their team and opponents
 - Never criticise team mates during the game
 - Always do as they are told by squad managers
 - Never use abusive language either on or off the pitch
 - Never get involved in violent conduct with opponents
 - Always accept the decision of the referee
- Never get involved in violent conduct either on or off the pitch
